<b>Segment II</b>	<b>Areas B-D:</b> <i>Students must have a minimum of 27 units in Segment II/Areas B-D (6 units min. in PBS; 9 unit min. in BSS and HCA)</i>
PBS-A	Any approved course in B1 or Segment II PBS-A
PBS-B	Any approved course in B2 or Segment II PBS-B
PBS-C	No longer required.
PBS-lab/field	Any approved course in B3 or Segment II PBS L/F course.
HCA Categories A through E <sup>3</sup>	Any approved course in Area C1, C2, or C3 or Segment II HCA (may be in one prefix).
BSS Categories A through C <sup>3</sup>	Any approved course in Area D1, D2, or D3 <sup>4</sup> or Segment II BSS (may be in one prefix).
<b>Segment III</b>	<b>Upper division GE:</b> <i>Continuing students are not required to complete a course in each upper division area (UD-B, C, and D); All three courses may double count with major</i>
Clusters	Any approved course in any Topical Perspective or Segment III. All may be double counted with major courses.
Study Abroad	Study Abroad: no changes for continuing students

LLD (in Segment II only)	Any approved course in Area E/LLD (in any part of undergraduate degree)
American Ethnic and Racial Minority (AERM; in Segment II only)	Any approved course in AERM (in any part of undergraduate degree)
CESD	Any course in upper division GE approved for the AERM <sup>5</sup> or Social Justice overlays
<b>Other graduation requirements</b>	
ENG 114	Any approved course in A2 or ENG 114 equivalent
AI-US History	Any approved course in D2 or upper division course certified for US History
AI-US/CA Government	Any approved course in D3 or upper division course certified for US and CA Government
OASIS	No longer required for graduation.

<sup>2</sup>Students taking Segment I courses Fall of 2014 or later must get a grade of CR or C- or better to fulfill General Education requirements.

<sup>3</sup>The same course may not be used for both Segment II and Segment III credit.

<sup>4</sup>American Institutions (AI) was not part of GE in the former program, but is included in Area D in the 2014 program. Students who have completed AI without completing a minimum of 9 units in BSS/Area D, must complete a minimum of 9 units in BSS/Area D. Beginning Fall 2014, continuing students who have not already completed AI may take courses in Areas D2 and D3 to satisfy both AI and BSS/Area D requirements.

<sup>5</sup>A course used to fulfill the AERM requirement may not also be used to fulfill the CESD requirement.
