

**Concluding Action Memorandum

This memorandum is based upon the Academic Program Review Committee (APRC) process, grounded in the following source materials:

1. Sexuality Studies Self-Study, September 2019
2. External Review Report, October 2019
3. Department response to the External Review Report, November 2019
4. College Dean response to documents, November 2019
5. Responses to APRC questions, February 2020

These responses were used to construct an integrated review of the program's strengths, accomplishments, challenges and plans for future action.

Provost's Statement

The program review process should serve as a basis for strategic planning, including curricular changes, development of new courses, hiring plans, resource requests, and space allocation. Future proposals that affect any of these aspects of the program/department should refer to program review documents, including this concluding action memo.

Commendations

The APRC commends the Sexuality Studies Program for:

1. Development of a nationally recognized, prestigious program, in which its goals and values strongly support the social justice mission of SFSU.
2. Commitment to student success and learning by creating clear pathways for students, emphasizing communication skills in its capstone course, and establishing a mentorship program for graduate students.
3. Collaboration with faculty across the university and within Sociology to have the unique, multidisciplinary identity of the field of Sexuality Studies reflected in the program.

- 4. Proactive efforts to recruit and diversify its program.

Recommendations

Based on the outcome of the program review, the Sexuality Studies Program is advised to take the following actions:


- 1. Pursue discussions with the Dean about strategies to develop a university-wide council and/or mechanism through which affiliated faculty outside of SXS can formalize ties with it. This proposed council can shape the program's direction and program learning outcomes. It might also support the implementation of the program's five-year plan and help in the development of a more multidisciplinary curriculum.
- 2. Continue to strengthen the MA program and pursue more strategies for recruitment, retention and diversification.
- 3. Leverage institutional ties with CREGS to promote more research and learning opportunities for undergraduate students and faculty.
- 4. Pursue online certificate opportunities that can meet student demand and offer needed curriculum.

CAM Follow-up Report

Two years after the CAM signing, the program submits a follow-up report to APRC outlining the steps taken to implement the CAM provisions. Subsequent follow-up reports can be requested by APRC.



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
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
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
